Reservation Modifications

These apply to Sites only and do not apply to Cabins!

These are the rules that our partners at Disney Central will be utilizing. We will be adhering to the same.

Disney Central Cast may not make any changes at all for Room Only or Package reservations including the dates listed. Reservations including these dates can be canceled but may not be modified in any way (including but not limited to: adding Guests, changing dates, or overriding minimum/maximum availability to reduce length of stay). If available, new reservations can be booked for these dates, including for cancel/rebook scenarios.

- Disney Central Cast may cancel/rebook from a Room Only reservation to a Package reservation, based on availability.
- Disney Central Cast may not make any name changes to the Lead Guest for any Campsite reservations. This includes Guest Services escalations. No exceptions will be made.
- Disney Central Cast may attempt to make other modifications requested by the Guest or travel agent via SBC. If SBC allows the change, you may make it.
- Reservations including these dates may not be modified in any way (including but not limited to: adding Guests, changing dates, or overriding minimum/maximum availability to reduce length of stay).
- Disney Central Cast may attempt to reduce the length of a Campsite reservation, based on availability, by modifying the END DATE ONLY.
- Disney Central Guest Services may not merge any continuing reservations for Campsite reservations. The Guest will be required to check out and check back in for all reservations.
- Disney Central Cast may not request or add any deposit extensions or money transfers for Campsite Reservations.

Fort Wilderness Resort and Campground Halloween Site Decorating Guidelines 2025

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all of our Guests, all decorations must comply with Walt Disney World Resort Property Rules and the specific requirements below.

We reserve the right to prohibit the use or storage of any item that we determine may be harmful or disruptive, in our sole and absolute discretion.

- Decorations should not encroach on neighboring sites.
- All decorations must be properly secured, not create a trip hazard and not obstruct day-to-day operations.
- Site post MUST remain visible at all times.
- Deck stairs must remain free and clear.
- Decorations should not be attached to the exterior of a cabin. Guests may not solicit or advertise sales, services or companies.
- Decorations may not contain suggestive, offensive or obscene material.
- Decorations and effects must abide by the quiet hours of the Resort.
- The display of flags, banners, signs or other materials for commercial purposes or as part of a demonstration is prohibited.
- Decorations that portray graphic or political violence are prohibited. However, certain classic Disney imagery from the past, which is no longer produced by Disney, may be still be displayed by some Guests. An example of this is the iconic depiction of Mickey Mouse holding a rifle. At this time, we will not require Guests to remove such classic cartoon imagery.
- Outdoor-rated extension cords and power splitters must be in good condition, kept out of path/walkway crossings and not connected to other splitters or dividers.

Halloween Golf Cart Guidelines Disney's Fort Wilderness Resort & Campground 2025

General Cart Rules

- •All Florida Rules of the road apply while operating carts on Fort Wilderness property, whether privately owned or a *Walt Disney World* rental.
- •Cart Drivers must be at least 16 years of age and hold a valid Driver's License. The License must remain with the driver at all times while operating the cart. Drivers Lerner Permits are **not** acceptable.
- •Children are not permitted to sit on the driver's lap. Young children may sit on the passengers lap while being secured by the passenger.
- •Children may not assist in driving the golf cart at any time.
- •Passengers in carts must stay seated at all times.
- •Every passenger must sit in a seat. No standing.
- •Carts must stay within Disney's Fort Wilderness Resort and Campground, carts must only be parked in designated cart areas.
- •Carts must remain on roadways and designated cart paths only. Off-roading is not permitted.
- •Larger vehicles have the "right of way". Carts must yield to larger vehicles. Keep to the right on roadways to allow larger vehicles to pass and yield pedestrians.

Golf cart privileges at Disney's Fort Wilderness Resort & Campground may be revoked from those notn abiding by the above rules and regulations.

Private Cart Rules

- •Follow general cart rules above.
- •Must be golf cart style carts; off road, ATV, utility or construction-type carts are not permitted.
- •Must have maximum speed to not exceed 20 mph.
- •Must be equipped with head lights and tail lights to operate after dusk.

Fort Wilderness Halloween Extravaganza Rules

- •Please arrive to the hitch and unhitch staging area no later than 4:00pm
- •Display the golf cart number you are given upon sign-up on the lower left hand side of your windshield for proper judging.
- •Someone 18 years or older must be present to sign the photo release waiver upon sign-up.
- •Towing of any additional wagons will result in disqualification from judging. Do not throw or hand out any items to the spectators, this will result in disqualification from judging.
- •Do NOT throw or hand out any items to the spectators, this will result in disqualification from judging.
- •For the safety and enjoyment of all: entries may not include themes, props, or decorations that depict or promote violence. Decorations that portray graphic or political violence are prohibited. However, certain classic Disney imagery from the past, which is no longer produced by Disney, may be still be displayed by some Guests. An example of this is the iconic depiction of Mickey Mouse holding a rifle. At this time, we will not require Guests to remove such classic cartoon imagery.
- •Decorated Guest carts cannot exceed 10 feet in width or exceed 8 feet tall in height from the ground.
- •Carts representing a political party and/or figure will not be allowed to participate.

Judges will select the top 6 golf carts from our extravaganza. If you are selected, you will be notified via the cell phone number you provided at the time of signing up. We will then ask you to display your golfcart outside of the Settlement Trading post from 7:00pm- 9:00pm.

Pumpkin Guidelines

Howdy! Thank you for entering in our 2025 pumpkin decorating contest.

- The judging for our contest will take place at the Settlement pumpkin drop-off location across from the Settlement Trading Post.
- Only one pumpkin (display) can be entered per Guest.
- If you would like to keep your pumpkin after the judging, please pick it upby 10:00pm on October 30th.
- We will be announcing the winners at our Halloween Beach Bash. Upon dropping your pumpkins off we will number them for the Guests to vote on their favorites.

Halloween Costume Contest Guidelines

Dressing for Halloween Events

Disney reserves the right to deny admission to or remove any person wearing attire that is considered inappropriate or attire that could detract from the experience of other Guests. Attire that is not appropriate for the property—and which may result in refusal of admittance—includes but is not limited to:

For Guests ages 13 and under:

Costumes and some costume masks may be worn; masks must provide unobstructed peripheral vision at all times with openings that allow the eyes to be fully seen.

For Guests 14 Years of Age or Older:

Costume masks of any kind may not be worn.

All Guests may dress as their favorite character, but may not pose for pictures or sign autographs for other Guests.

Costumes must be family-friendly; and not obstructive, offensive, objectionable or violent.

Costumes may not contain any props or accessories that resemble or could easily be mistaken for an actual weapon.

Costumes may not contain sharp objects, pointed objects or materials that may accidentally strike another Guest.

Costumes may not reach or drag on the ground. (for example, full-length Princess dresses)

Capes may be worn if the length does not go below the waist.

Themed T-shirts, blouses, sweatshirts and hats are acceptable.

Acceptable accessories include: transparent wings, plastic light sabers, toy swords and tutus. Costume headwear may be worn as long as it does not cover the face.

- Camp or Treat will take place from 6-9 PM.
 Access to the Cloverleaf Loops (1600,1700,1800, and 1900) will be restricted. All vehicle traffic will be limited to golf carts.
- All candy handed out must be prepackaged.
- All candy handed out must be attended (leaving bowls at your campsite is prohibited).
- Drinking and driving is strictly prohibited and will be enforced.
