

PUBLIC NOTICE

Important information about your drinking water

Monitoring Requirements Not Met

On 6/25/2025 we became aware that our system recently failed to collect the correct number of drinking water samples. Although this incident was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During May we did not monitor or test for total coliform and total chlorine residuals and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

This is not an emergency. There is nothing you need to do at this time. You may continue to drink the water. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours.

Your public water supply is reviewing their annual monitoring schedule and verifying that they have all the materials required to sample monthly per their total coliform & total chlorine residual schedule. They will reach out to MDH, or their contract laboratory as needed. The City of Babbitt Public Utilities ensures that only those two test items were missed in May, and all other scheduled tests have been performed, and have verified safe drinking water.
